As this year we have a President's Reception rather than a dinner, we don't know what the *minhag* will be.... In any event, because this is *minhag* and not *din*, this is only *aytza tova*.

7. Please note there is no convention lunch for Thursday.

8. If you want to bring materials for distribution or sale we will have a space available for display. Please note that anything not picked up by the end of the convention has to be taken back with you or it gets thrown away. As a general guideline, we average 80-100 people at a convention if you're counting copies.
