I am co-Chair of the 2010 NOLA LimmudFest Program Team, and am writing to let you know that the Jewish community of Greater New Orleans will be having our first Limmud close to the time of the RRA convention, on March 13-14th. As this may be of interest to some of you attending your conference, note that the program starts Saturday night with a community havdalah ceremony, a round of sessions and then a late night Jazz and Jam. It then continues all day Sunday. We have close to 70 speakers for the 24 hour event, with nine tracks running simultaneously: Southern Jewish Experience, Text and Tradition, Social Justice & Activism, Arts & Culture, Israel, Contemporary Jewish Identity, History & Society, Spirituality & Ritual, and Family. A Camp Limmud program will be run simultaneously for younger Limmudniks.
