

## RRA 2012 Convention: General Information

4. **Please bring your own copy of the Kol Haneshamah:Limot Hol siddur.** We will only have a few extra copies available on site. Also, remember your *tallit* and/or *tefillin*.
5. The *minhag* for the Tuesday night President's dinner is that dress is somewhat less casual/more formal. As this is *minhag* and not *din*, this is simply *aytza tova*.
6. Please note there is no convention lunch for Wednesday and this year we are not offering box lunch to go option.
7. If you want to bring materials for distribution or sale we will have a space available for display. *No one is available to staff sales so you are responsible for managing payments.* Please note that anything not picked up by the end of the convention has to be taken back with you or it gets thrown away. As a general guideline, we average 80-100 people at a convention if you're counting copies.

9. Food: Convention meals taken together are kosher by ingredients but not by *kelim*. If you have any *kashrut* concerns please let Amy Loewenthal know as soon as possible. The registration form has a space for indicating special food needs and/or concerns and/or allergies.
